August 12, 2015

Meeting was called to order at 7:10pm by President Marian Milender.

Minutes from the July 8, 2015 meeting were read by Marian Milender. No changes or corrections were suggested. Paul Fritz moved to approve the minutes. Adam Ledger seconded. Approved.

Committee Reports

Christian Service/Social Action: Our parish donated 77.7 pounds of goods to the Lord's Cupboard. There will be a blood drive at Mother Cabrini on Monday, August 17 from 2:00-6:30pm. Congregate meals continue to be held on the fourth Thursday of every month through October.

Family Life: No report

Liturgy: Special music for the Mass on September 20 (Auction/Dinner) is being discussed. Amy Webber reports that a parishioner suggested that the parish start calling/reminding individuals who are scheduled as liturgical ministers for Mass. No action taken at this time. Jo-Ann Zager complimented the choir on the music from the August 9 Mass. There were no instruments played, but the choir members came out and faced the congregation to sing. She found it very engaging. Marian Milender will make special effort to have the organists put the version of the Gloria to be used at Mass on the music board.

Maintenance: Steve Pacha and Adam Ledger worked on the bell tower. Adam repositioned a screen that had tipped in, and they both worked on hanging a rope so the bell can be rung manually. Mike Adrian said he needed to get a copy of the receipt from Altar and Rosary for the last shingle roof replacement on the SJ Rectory to follow up on warranty. Paul Fritz reported that he found the dehumidifier not working and the basement of the SJ Rectory very wet on August 2. He brought his own dehumidifier and is drying the basement. He also scrubbed some mold off of the basement stairwell. Shirley Van Dee reports that Garry Dickey trimmed trees at Mother Cabrini to facilitate mowing underneath them. Mike and Jerry Adrian hauled the trimmings away.

Faith Formation: We had a retreat for the Confirmation students at the Youth Camp at Lake Darling on August 8-9. Fairfield did not attend. We had 13 attend and had 5 speakers. It was a very nice retreat.

Parish Life: Paul Fritz reports website usage of 25-35 visits per week for the past month. Shirley Van Dee suggested that we post the upcoming 2015 ADA booklet.

Altar and Rosary: Rosemary Pacha reports that A&R met yesterday and finalized work assignments. They intend to distribute them at Mass on August 23. A&R has planned another social gathering. Next one will be on Thursday, October 1 at 6pm and Four Corners Restaurant north of Lockridge, IA.

Finance: Amy Webber reviewed the Profit and Loss Budget Performance July 2014 through June 2015. The parish ended up with a little more income than expense for the fiscal year: \$12,228.04. Profit and Loss Budget Performance for July 2015 was also reviewed. It contains no budgeted numbers because the parish budget has not yet been formalized. It is also somewhat skewed because the major fundraiser (Annual Auction and Dinner) is not yet included.
